

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTING NATIONALITY APPLICATIONS

NATIONALITY BY DESCENT APPLICATIONS

1. Application Form must be properly completed –
 - Form N1 (Adults)
 - Form N3 (Children)
2. Fee US\$100.00 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
3. Applicant's Birth Certificate.
 - a) Birth certificate must be apostilled, if applicant does not hold a passport from his/her country of birth.
 - b) Where the birth certificate is in a language that is other than the English language, an original translation of the birth certificate is required. (official translation only)
4. Proof of Belizean Parents:
 - a) Birth Certificate and a copy of a photo identification or Copy of parent's Belizean Passport.
 - b) Belize Nationality Certificate and a copy of a photo identification or Copy of parent's Belizean Passport.
5. Marriage certificate:
 - a) Where the applicant is a married woman and wishes that her certificate be made out in her marriage name or
 - b) Where at the time of the birth of the child the mother was unmarried but at the time of the application, her passport or ID is in her marriage name.
6. 4 Photographs (must be 2"x2" in size, taken with a frontal view, white background, no sleeveless and taken within the last six months and in keeping with passport photo requirements)

Additional Information

- Parent's signature should match that of ID provided
- Justice of the Peace must sign and date application.
- Ensure the correct spelling of names are on documents.
- Both original and photocopies of documents must be presented.
- Correction liquid on application forms is not acceptable
